## MACNEILS, Accountants *This business life*

The Australian Taxation Office has cracked down hard on taxpayers failing to lodge their Activity Statements on time. Regardless of the fact that you may have paid all monies owing on the statement before the due date, if you have not actually lodged the statement with the ATO, you can receive a very hefty fine.

When the GST regime first started, the ATO was taking an 'educational' perspective on overdue lodgements, and merely warned people of the possibility of fines. They now believe that taxpayers have had ample time to adapt to the rules, and fines of \$550 or more could be imposed.

Don't waste your hard earned cash on penalties! Make sure your Activity Statements reach the ATO by the due date.
