Farm Management Deposits provide farmers with an option for spreading profit over a number of years. It is another form of averaging and has been very useful to many farmers over the last seven years or so.

What is imperative is to keep an eye on the deposits and withdrawals from those FMD's. The last couple of months of the financial year are crucial to tax planning for the 30th June. If you have withdrawn an FMD this year, TELL YOUR ACCOUNTANT before the 30th June. Your tax bill will reflect that withdrawal.

Alternatively, discuss the option of putting money into a deposit as a tax planning measure. Just remember, after the 30th June is too late. Talk now.

ChemCert is one of the rural sector's most successful training programmes in the use of farm chemicals.

This course will assist you to manage risks associated with chemical use, and to understand your obligations in the areas of duty of care, quality assurance and environmental management. On a practical level you'll learn how to improve your integrated pest management programmes, to better choose the right chemical for the job and to apply it more accurately. Care is taken to ensure that you understand how to calibrate spray equipment, and how to ensure safe working conditions for your workers, your family and yourself.
