\$200 Training Vouchers Available

The Western Australian Department of Education and Training is offering businesses a **Small Business Smart Business Training Voucher** up to \$200 towards the cost of training to improve business management skills. These Vouchers may also be used to attend relevant conferences, seminars, coaching or mentoring programs.

Training costs of \$100 or less are reimbursed in full. Training costs greater than \$100, will have the first \$100 reimbursed, plus 50% of the balance, to a maximum of a further \$100.

To be eligible for a **Small Business Smart Business Training Voucher**, the business must have an ABN, employ less than 20 people (full & part-time) and have the training approved by the Warren Blackwood Small Business Centre prior to the commencement of training. If you have previously applied for a training voucher you are still eligible to apply again in this round.

Note: Training voucher must be redeemed within 60 days of the completion of training, or by 31/12/2009, whichever is the earlier date. Vouchers received after the specified date will be deemed invalid and payment will not be made.
